	INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND SECTION 116(3) PROCESS TO BE FOLLOWED

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Section 116(3) of the Municipal Finance Management Act (Act 56 of 2003) (MFMA) prescribes that public participation is required whenever a local authority intends to amend or extend a contract procured through its municipal supply chain management policy.

2. SECTION 116(3) PROCESS TO BE FOLLOWED

Section 116 of the MFMA refers to the section regarding **CONTRACTS AND CONTRACT MANAGEMENT**. As required by the MFMA, a municipality is therefore required to provide information and to invite written comments from the local community and affected parties and/or persons for the proposed amendment of contracts procured through the municipal supply chain management policy.

Section 116(3) of the MFMA stipulates the following:

- 3) A contract or agreement procured through the supply chain management policy of the municipality or municipal entity may be amended by the parties, but only after
 - a) the reasons for the proposed amendment have been tabled in the council of the municipality or, in the case of a municipal entity, in the council of its parent municipality; and
 - b) the local community—
 - (i) has been given reasonable notice of the intention to amend the contract or agreement; and
 - (ii) has been invited to submit representations to the municipality or municipal entity.

3. PROJECT BACKGROUND

The primary objective of this service is as follow:

- a) To provide an interoperability solution (interconnect) between the "On-Premise Collaborator solution" to facilitate the exchange of information between the Western Cape Collaborator Portal (external stakeholders) and the "On-Premise" Collaborator Solution used within the Prince Albert Municipality;
- b) Host the extension (portal) Collaborator Foundation System of Prince Albert Municipality in the Business Engineering Hosting Environment (Azure).

The main services provided are as follow:

- Provide electronic workflow, record and document management solutions;
- On-site support services
- Data storage and disaster recovery services

4. CONTRACT DETAILS

Contract ending date: 30 JUNE 2024

Contract value: R 994 406.91 (Inclusive of VAT)

5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATION OF AMENDMENT

Section 116 of the Municipal Finance Management Act (Act 56 of 2003), read together with MFMA Circular 62 (Supply Chain Management, enhancing compliance and accountability) states that contracts may be expanded or varied by not more than **twenty percent (20%) for construction related goods**, services and/or infrastructure projects and **fifteen percent (15%) for all other goods and/or services** of the original value of the contract.

Below is an indication of the financial implications for such contract amendment:

6. MOTIVATION FOR AMENDMENT

The municipality advertised formally advertised a new tender (Advertised under Tender 63/2024) for the supply, delivery and installation of an electronic records, document and workflow system for a contract period of three (3) years, which closed on 18 June 2024. As a result of receiving a high volume of bids, which must be evaluated, together with the appeal period after adjudication, it was impractical to appoint a service provider before 30 June 2024, in order to implement the new contract.

These uncontrollable variables as expected has had an adverse impact on the project timeframe for implementation. Therefore, the extension will allow the municipality to proceed with the current contract and implementation of key deliverables and objectives as set out in such contract.
