Prince Albert Municipality hereby invites tenders for the CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW 200KL POTABLE WATER STORAGE RESERVOIR AND PROVISION OF ABLUTION BLOCKS TO THE INFORMAL SETTLEMENT OF KLAARSTROOM. A set of tender documents <u>must be reserved</u> at the consulting engineer (Royal HaskoningDHV). Tender documents will be available at a non-refundable cost of R 500.00 (VAT Included), payable in cash at the cashiers at the Prince Albert Municipality's Financial Building, 23 Church Street, Prince Albert or EFT deposit in favour of the Prince Albert Municipality ABSA Bank, Account number 26-4056-0064 Reference: T40/2021 and company name.

Reservation of the document can be done upon receipt of the documentation fee, and the issue of a municipal receipt or acknowledgement. Documents must be reserved by no later than **Friday 19 March** @ **13h00**. Contact details for reservations and technical enquiries are as follow:

A **compulsory tender clarification meeting** will be held at the Klaarstroom Community Centre, Bloekom Street, Klaarstroom at 11H00 on Thursday 25 March 2021. Tenderers who arrive after 11H15 will not be allowed to join the clarification meeting. Tenderers are advised that the compulsory clarification meeting will be conducted in adherence to the relevant COVID-19 Lockdown Regulations promulgated for such assemblies.

Bidders are required to be registered at the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB). Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations for a **3CE** class of construction work are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

The closing time for submission of bids is **13h30 on Thursday 01 April 2021**. Bids must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the bid number and title given above and placed in the **bid box at the Administration Building, 33 Church Street, Prince Albert**, on or before the mentioned time and latest date. **Telephonic, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted.** Bids must remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid. Notwithstanding the period for validity of bids as set out in the bid documents, bids shall be deemed to remain valid until formal acceptance by the Prince Albert Municipality of an offer at any time after the expiry of the original validity period, unless the Prince Albert Municipality is notified in writing of anything to the contrary (including any further conditions) by the bidder.

Bids will be opened on the same day at the Council Chambers (Municipal Administration Building) at 13h30. Late or unmarked bids will not be considered.

Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.

This bid is subject to Local Production and Content.

Stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content for Electrical and Telecom Cables of 90%, Stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content for Steel value-added products of 100%, Stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content for Plastic Pipes (PVC, HDPE, PP, GRP) of 100% and Stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content for Valve products and actuators of 70% is applicable on this bid.

The evaluation of this bid will be subjected to functionality scoring. Bidders must obtain the minimum functionality score in order for the bid to be responsive. Bidders who do not meet the minimum functionality scoring as indicated, will be regarded as non-responsive.

Bids will be evaluated according to the **80/20** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NO BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED FROM PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN THE MUNICIPAL SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS (GOVERNMENT GAZETTE NO 40553 DATED 20 JANUARY 2017).
